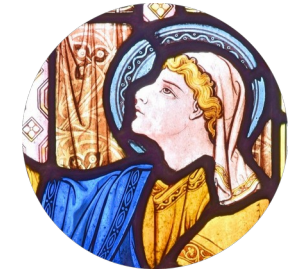
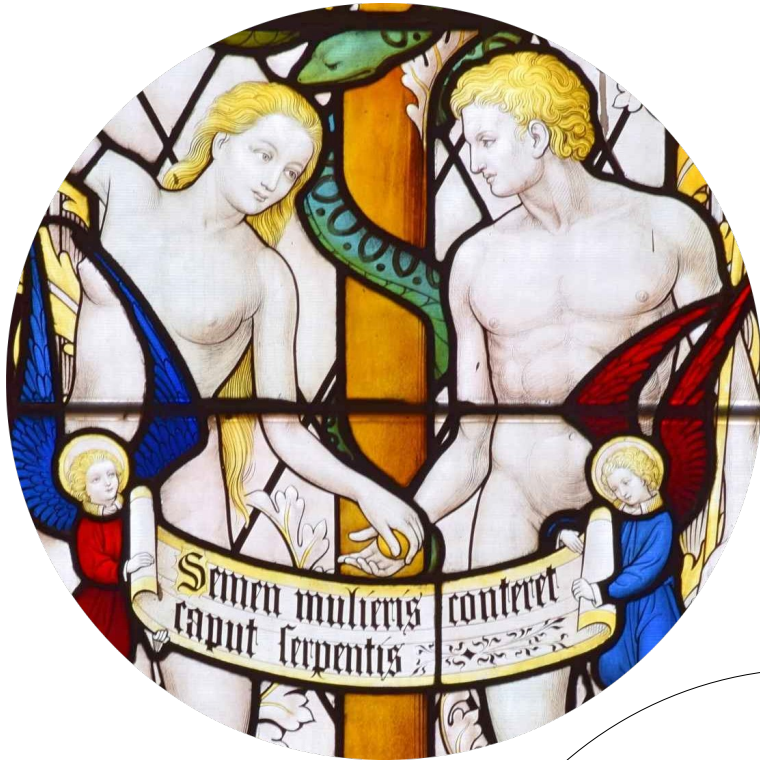


The Jesse Tree: Printable Ornaments

(Galatians 3:8)



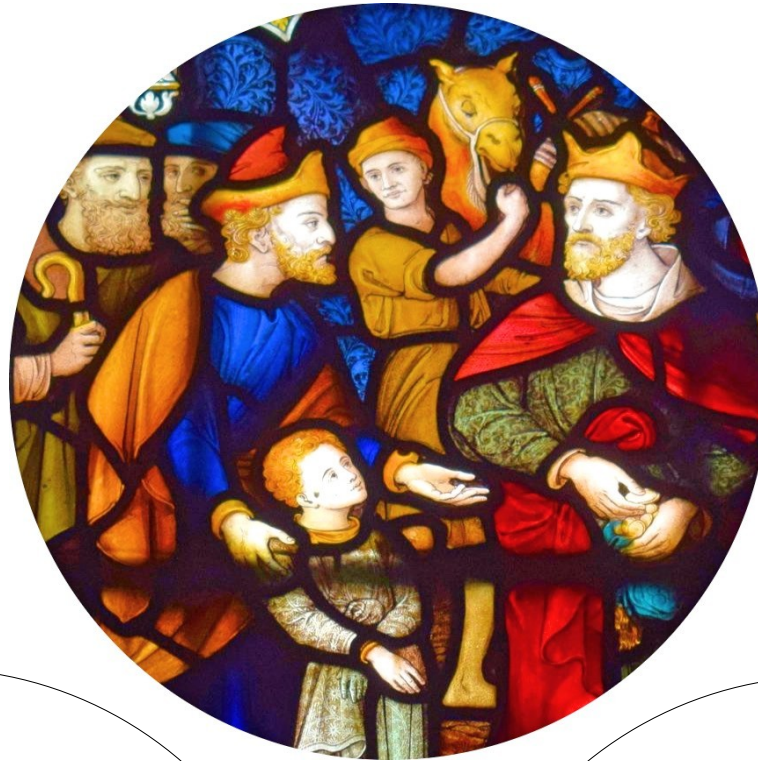
4. Isaac

(Isaiah 7:14)



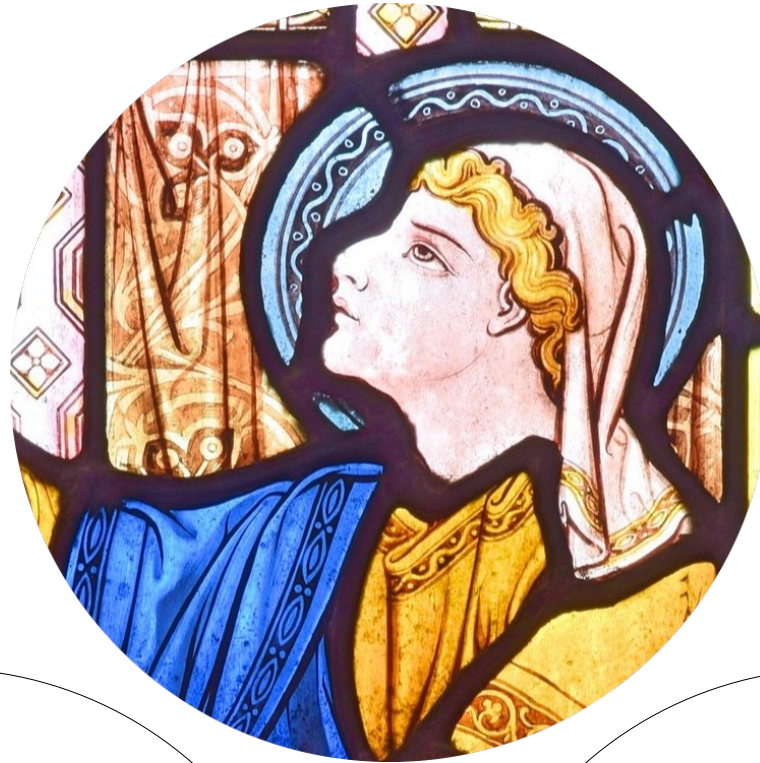
16. The Prophet Jeremiah
